If you are in both 4H and the Open Light Horse show you must enter separately for each show, complete an entry for each horse/rider combo.

Include Stalling, Shavings, Environmental & Office fees, Additional Gate & Vehicle passes

Payment is available through Assist Expo by credit card, cheque or etransfer to paex@sasktel.net . Include in the message area if Light Horse Show or 4H and Exhibitors name.

RV CAMPING Camping can be booked through Assist Expo at the same time as you make your entries (\$25.00/night plus GST = \$26.25) or call Campground Manager, Wayne - 306-960-1743 to book a site. PAEX office will notify you of your site (should receive within 48 hours). If you have not received notification please contact campground manager. If manager not available call 306-961-8916. If there is an issue with your site please contact campground manager.

PARKING If you have booked a stall, enter the grounds at the East entrance – 10th Avenue East, follow the dirt road, past the Main building and park behind the barns.

If you are only showing for the day enter grounds at 8th Avenue East, (from 7th Street), follow road along North Ring, turn right and enter grass area near Brown show office.

Exhibitors name will be on list at gates. Light Horse Show Stalls will be assigned to Barn 4, 4H Clubs will be assigned to Barn 1. Name of Exhibitor will be put on stall door, shavings bags will be left outside stalls.

PASSES Each exhibitor will receive a FREE gate pass and a FREE vehicle pass for vehicle pulling trailer. Please buy additional passes accordingly. if you are camping, you will also receive a FREE vehicle pass for that vehicle.

PAEX 4-H Light Horse Show Rules

Entries MUST Be Received by July 26th 2024!!

Stalls will be available during the day, Tuesday, July 31

PLEASE REVIEW ALL RULES

ALL PA EXHIBITION EXHIBITORS RULES WILL APPLY WHERE APPLICABLE

1. Cloverbuds- 6-8 years of age on or before December 31,2023, Junior- 9-12 years of age on or before December 31, 2023. Intermediate- 13-15 years of age on or before December 31, 2023, Senior- 16-21 years of age or before December 31, 202.
2. ENTRANTS CAN ONLY USE ONE HORSE AND MUST BE YOUR CURRENT 4-H YEAR PROJECT HORSE.
3. No stallions allowed in the 4-H classes.
4. Each 4-H rider must own or have possession of horse at least 4 months prior to date of show and it must be a horse which has been used in 4-H Club work. In the case the horse cannot be shown on account of injury or illness, another eligible horse may be used. Club Leader to certify that substitution was necessary.
5. Parade of Clubs and Special Event class are open to club members only.
6. ONLY CLUB LEADERS CAN MAKE ENTRIES FOR CLUB CLASSES
7. Each horse will be allotted program number and each exhibitor must wear the same as a blanket number. No exhibitor shall be permitted to show without a number. Any error made due to an exhibitor wearing a wrong number will cancel points credited to that exhibitor in that class. Numbers must be clearly visible.
8. All horses having completed 4-H events and not entered into any other classes must vacate barns following the end of the 4-H show.
9. Any sponsors of awards or prize money will not be allowed to judge in that class to avoid possible conflict of interest. Judges will be chosen by the Light Horse Committee.
10. STABLE FEES: Box stalls \$10.00/day, Tie stalls \$5.00/day. Early or late stalling arrivals must be approved by the committee. Box stall doors must be kept closed. Stabling will be allocated by the Light Horse Committee without right of appeal and will be awarded by the first come

basis. It may not be possible to accommodate all requests. Stabling fees must accompany entry form. Exhibitors will not move their assigned stalls.

11. TACK STALLS WILL BE DESIGNATED IF ENTRIES PERMIT. NO GROOMING OF HORSES IN AISLES. HORSES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN ANY AREA OF THE TRAILER PARK. BARNs MUST BE KEPT CLEAN AT ALL TIMES DURING THE FAIR. STALLS MUST BE LEFT IN CLEAN CONDITION WHEN CLASSES ARE FINISHED.

12. Each exhibitor will receive a FREE gate pass and a FREE vehicle pass for vehicle pulling trailer. Please buy additional passes accordingly. if you are camping, you will also receive a FREE vehicle pass for that vehicle.

13. Following the show, all stalls must be left clean.

14. 4-H members, parents and leaders please be reminded that Trailer Park applications are accepted on a first come, first paid, first reserved basis. The P.A. Ex can't guarantee trailer spots.

15. All complaints that are given in writing will be accepted and acknowledged (see General PA EX rules)

16. AS PER SHF RULES, ALL MEMBERS UNDER 18 MUST WEAR HELMETS IN ALL RIDING CLASSES.

17. ADULTS/NON-4-H MEMBERS will not be allowed to physically prepare or groom 4-H project animals for the show ring (Saskatchewan 4-H).

18. At least one leader, project leader must be available at the show ring during the 4-H show.

19. Horses of any age can be ridden with snaffle bit, 4-H classes only.

20. Points will be tabulated using the following point scale. Five or more in a class 5,4,3,2,1.

21. Prize money: 1st - \$10, 2nd - \$7, 3rd - \$5, 4th - \$3.
